The design will focus on long-term maintenance and livability using the latest technologies and durable materials, finishes and fixtures. The house will be fully compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act and will contain suite space specifically for handicapped members.

The house will provide competitive accommodations and social amenities for the 21st century, as well as a pleasant living and learning environment. Until the start of construction in Summer 2013 we continue to maintain the existing facility.
